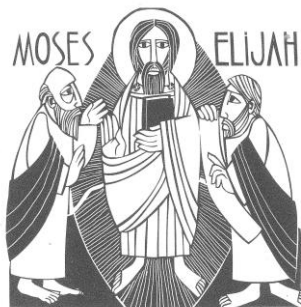

**SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT:** This is my Son the Beloved. Listen to him.

**FR ROB** has been in hospital since last Friday with Pancreatitis, it is gradually coming under control. He thanks everyone for their prayers.

**COFFEE AND TEA AFTER MASS:** Coffee and Tea will be served after all Masses this weekend. Do come and join us in the Parish Centre.

**CORONAVIRUS:** Following guidance from the diocese, we have decided to implement the following measures in the interests of hygiene:

- From now on Holy Communion will no longer be distributed under both kinds.
- The sign of peace will be either omitted or replaced by a bow.
- In some places people are being encouraged to receive Holy Communion in the hand only.
- We will be endeavouring to supply hand sanitizer gel for the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and for everyone attending Mass.

This is a developing situation and these measures may well be updated.

**THE GOD WHO SPEAKS:** The second evening celebrating, understanding and praying the Word of God will take place on Friday 20th March at 7pm in the Parish Conference Room.

**200 CLUB:** The January and February draw will take place during coffee after the 10.30 Mass.
